An unexploded U.S. bomb left over from World War II has been found at a sewage system construction site in Shuri district in Naha city.

The unexploded bomb will be disarmed and removed by Japanese Self-Defense Forces on Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> September. Therefore, Okinawa police department will restrict traffic and the entry of the designated area is strictly prohibited during the specified time period.

We will change the operation of the hotel on Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> September as we are located within the evacuation zone.

Sunday, 29th September 2024

Disarm and Removal of Unexploded Bomb

- Evacuation begins at 8:50 am
- Traffic restrictions at 9:50 am
- Disarming and removal of the unexploded bomb at 10:00 am
- Expected completion by 2:00 pm

※Exiting the hotel is strictly prohibited from 9:50 am to 2:00 pm.
